



Merseyside's Progressive Conference and Training Facility

Directions to The Gateway Conference Centre:

Entrance to the Gateway Centre is through automatic doors (opening inwards) at the front of the building. You may have to press the intercom button situated on the left-hand side of the door to gain access. There is limited on-site visitor car-parking (reserved for pre-booked disabled drivers only) at the rear of the building, accessed from Wilde Street at the end of the Gateway Centre. There is a videophone/ intercom system next to the gate: press button to be connected to the receptionist.

BY RAIL & FOOT (From Liverpool Lime St Station - walking time is about 5-7 minutes)

- ⇒ Take rear exit from station (right hand exit with back to platforms) on Lord Nelson Street, turn left onto Lime Street then turn right and walk past the Empire Theatre.
- ⇒ Turn right up London Road and cross at the pedestrian crossing outside the Odeon Cinema.
- ⇒ Whilst walking up London Road you will cross over two side streets – Fraser Street and Wilde Street.
- ⇒ Once you have crossed Wilde Street, the Gateway Centre is the blue building immediately on your left hand side.
- ⇒ The entrance doors are just before the traffic lights.

BY BUS (To Pembroke Place / London Road)

- ⇒ The following buses stop at Pembroke Place / London Rd
- ⇒ Most Buses from Huyton / Stockbridge Village / West Derby / Page Moss / Old Swan / Kensington
- ⇒ Most buses from Kirkby / Broad Lane / Gillmoss / Anfield / Everton
- ⇒ Smart 3: City Centre (Paradise Street Bus Station)
- ⇒ No. 100: Dingle circular via the City Centre or 500 from John Lennon Airport stopping at National Xpress Stn.

BY CAR (From the end of M62)

- ⇒ At the end of the motorway follow the signs for the Albert Dock complex.
- ⇒ This takes you on the A5047 Edge Lane.
- ⇒ Continue along A5047 for about 3½ miles until you reach a junction where you must either turn left or right.
- ⇒ Turn right at this junction, still following the signs for the Albert Dock complex onto Hall Lane passing the Royal Liverpool University Hospital on your left.
- ⇒ Go straight across the next traffic lights (Prescot St). Keep in the left hand lane and this filters you down onto the A580 Islington (dual carriageway).
- ⇒ About ½ mile along this road, at the next set of traffic lights, after the Petrol Station turn left into Norton St. (there is a car park on the near side corner and the National Express Coach Station on the far corner).
- ⇒ Once you have turned into Norton St you will see The Gateway Centre – it is the 6 storey tall blue building on the right hand side next to the Neurosupport Centre building, with Brunelli's Café on the ground floor.
- ⇒ To access local pay and display car parks, turn left into Kempston St. (large John Moores University building on the corner). These car parks fill up very quickly however after 8AM.

PRIORITY CAR PARKING

The Gateway Conference Centre has Priority Car parking available at The Liner Hotel which is just 2 minutes walk from the Centre on the corner of Lord Nelson Street and St Vincent Way. From Norton Street, continue across the traffic lights with London Road and turn first right at the lights then take the car park entrance on the left hand side. Priority Spaces must be booked in advance. For full directions to the Liner Hotel please visit: www.theliner.co.uk The cost of this is £5 per car when booked with Gateway. Receipts are available from Gateway Reception.

- ⇒ Turn right out of the car park to the top of Lord Nelson Street
- ⇒ Turn left onto St Vincent's Way to the corner of London Road
- ⇒ Cross at the Pedestrian crossing.
- ⇒ The Gateway Conference Centre is the Blue building, the Main Entrance is to the left
- ⇒ Please report to the main Reception
